Internship Program Overview

Our internship program offers opportunities for individuals passionate about social justice and human rights to contribute to achieving freedom, justice, and restoration for survivors of human trafficking and other forms of modern slavery. Through hands-on experience and guidance from experienced professionals, interns will gain valuable skills while making a meaningful impact on JVIT's efforts to combat modern slavery.

The intern will be assigned a project at the beginning of the internship period and report to the assigned supervisor. The intern may also be assigned to a project that requires collaboration with other departments at JVIT.

INTERNSHIP POSITIONS

Legal Team

Responsibilities:

- Research and prepare legal memoranda on a range of issues pertaining to the relevant laws of India and other countries, including government entitlements, human rights, criminal law, employment, health and welfare, and international law.
- Assist in the development and editing of manuals and other publications outlining the laws of India and Nepal on government entitlements and human rights issues.
- Collect and analyze data on trends in human rights issues in South Asia and prepare reports and presentations for the leadership team.
- Assist with developing content for an online resource center dedicated to the legal practice of fighting human rights abuse in South Asia.

- Current enrollment in an accredited law school required
- Excellent legal research, analysis, and writing skills
- Proficiency in reading, writing, and comprehending national and state laws in Hindi and other regional languages based on location.
- Passion for social justice and a commitment to the mission of ending human trafficking and modern slavery
