## **INTRODUCTION**

### **Internship Program Overview**

Our internship program offers opportunities for individuals passionate about social justice and human rights to contribute to achieving freedom, justice, and restoration for survivors of human trafficking and other forms of modern slavery. Through hands-on experience and guidance from experienced professionals, interns will gain valuable skills while making a meaningful impact on JVIT's efforts to combat modern slavery.

The intern will be assigned a project at the beginning of the internship period and report to the assigned supervisor. The intern may also be assigned to a project that requires collaboration with other departments at JVIT.

## **INTERNSHIP POSITIONS**

### **Social Work Team**

#### *Responsibilities:*

- Assist in crisis intervention by providing immediate assistance and support to victims of human trafficking, including situations of abuse, exploitation, or re-trafficking.
- Assist in the case management process for trafficking survivors, including conducting intake assessments and coordinating aftercare services.
- Assist in capacity-building through training sessions and workshops to enhance knowledge and skills related to human trafficking, trauma-informed care, and social work practice
- Conduct outreach and educational campaigns to increase awareness of modern slavery and other injustices
- Assist in advocacy and policy framing at the local and national level

#### *Experience and Qualifications:*

- Current enrollment in Bachelors/Masters in Social Work or recently graduated from an accredited university required
- Proficiency in Hindi and English is mandatory. Proficiency in regional languages based on location is a plus.

- Excellent research, analysis, writing, and communication skills
- Passion for social justice and a commitment to the mission of ending human trafficking and modern slavery

### **Location**

All positions are currently available for those living in New Delhi, Kolkata, and Mumbai. Hybrid arrangements will be considered.

Internship positions are available on a flexible basis, ranging from one to three months, with the possibility of extension based on performance and organizational needs.
